---

The Academic Common Market of the Southern Regional Educational Board enables states and their higher education institutions to share specialized graduate and undergraduate academic programs. More than 1200 programs at over 130 colleges and universities are currently available to residents of Alabama, Arkansas, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Maryland, Mississippi, Oklahoma, South Carolina, Tennessee, Texas, Virginia, and West Virginia.

For residents of SREB states, the Academic Common Market gives them a broader range of educational opportunities with the benefit of only paying *in-state tuition* rates when they enroll in these selected programs in other SREB states.

The Masters degree program in Fire and Emergency Management Administration has recently been accepted into the Academic Common Market. Both current and prospective students interested in this program need to contact their respective state Regents Advisor (listed below), who will petition the Oklahoma State Regents coordinator for program acceptance. Once accepted, students will then be able to partake in the benefits of the Academic Common Market.
