

OUT-OF-STATE TUITION WAIVER PROGRAMS

TEACHING AND RESEARCH ASSISTANTSHIPS

The University awards assistantships. The terms of the appointment and the amount of the stipend vary by departments. Service is expected for assistantship appointments. Information regarding the application process should be addressed to the department in which the appointment is desired.

Non-resident graduate students who hold assistantship appointments of one-fourth time or more may have the out-of-state portion of their tuition waived. Questions on assistantships should be addressed to the department in which the appointment is held.

SPOUSE TUITION WAIVERS

Spouses of non-resident students who are on departmental assistantships may receive a waiver of their out-of-state tuition. Contact the Registrar's office (Lori Morris) at (405) 744-6866 for procedural information.

STRATEGIC TUITION WAIVERS

Graduate students who belong to an underrepresented group at OSU and do *not* hold department assistantships may be eligible for a waiver of their out-of-state tuition. Eligible applicants should contact the head of their department at the beginning of each semester. This waiver is not limited to new students or ethnic minorities.

ACADEMIC (TOP 20%) NON-RESIDENT TUITION WAIVERS

Incoming, domestic students with a GRE, GMAT, or MAT composite score in the 80th percentile and above may qualify for a full waiver of their non-resident tuition. Eligible applicants should send a written request as well as a copy of their standardized test scores to the Graduate College. Contact the Graduate College for more information.

****All tuition waivers, including non-resident waivers, do NOT waive extension, UCT, audit, or correspondence classes.
